Exams: There are two midterm exams, and one final. All are multiple-choice, and you will need a #2 pencil (for bubble sheets). You may use a calculator (and you will need one), but you may not share a calculator with anyone else. Cell phone calculators are not allowed.

The exam dates are **Thursday October 5**th & **Thursday November 9**th from **7-830 PM.** The final exam is Friday **December 15**th at **1030** am. There will be no early makeup exams for the final. All locations TBA.

Make up midterms—Make ups will only be given for a university approved reason (ie two exams at the same time). Make up exams MUST be requested (by providing documentation) no later than 2 weeks before the exam at 5pm. These deadlines will be **September 21**st and October 26th respectively. In order to request a makeup exam you must provide documentation to your course instructor by the date listed above. This can be obtained from the registrar. If you miss both the makeup and regular exam (illness, death, etc) you may be eligible to take a supermakeup which takes place during the last week of classes or the first week of finals. You must contact your instructor within 48 hours of the exam and provide documentation supporting your university approved absence as soon as you return to campus.
